	BRIEF EXPLANATION ON WHAT IT IS OR HOW TO USE IT
{{bury}}	This is a verb and is when you dig a hole and cover it over
{{berry}}	This is what the birds eat and are found on trees. We eat them too in the form of strawberries and raspberries.
{{its}}	This is a possessive. "The dog hurt its leg"
{{it's}}	This is the shortened version of it is.
{{mane}}	This is the longer hair on an animal
{{main}}	This word means leading or principal
{{except}}	This is a preposition and means not including
{{accept}}	This is a verb that can mean saying yes to something offered
{{precede}}	This is a verb which means come before. For example, The stone age precedes the bronze age.
{{proceed}}	This is a verb which means to move forward
{{alternate}}	This is a verb or an adjective and both mean every other. For example, he goes to see his uncle alternate weeks (adj). He wants to alternate between cricket one week and hockey the next.
{{alternative}}	This is an adjective and means another option. For example, she has an alternative pair of shoes to wear.
{{buoy}}	This is something that floats in the sea which you can tie your boat to
